I always had a pain inside me that I wanted to draw and keep it for myself. I had no intention of doing anything with the work I was creating. However, I used to draw every day in a cafe until I met a painter named Amir Mohammadzadeh. He saw my work and encouraged me not to work for anyone else and start my own street gallery. But when I entered the street and understood the social pain, I unconsciously drew a childhood image of a child working on the street or heard the sound of a woman's scream.




### MY HOMELAND


